

ABERGELE GC: LOCAL RULES 2019

Out of bounds (Rule 18)

A ball coming to rest beyond any wall, fence or rows of white posts, defining the boundaries of the course

i.e. Measured from nearest inside point of stakes at ground level. (see def. 0.0.B)

Also, out of bounds:

- a) Concrete paths around the clubhouse, car park, flower beds and practice e) putting Green.
- b) Beyond white posts defining practice area, green keeper storage area on the 151 hole
- c) On or beyond the horizontal telegraph poles to the right of the 1st hole.
- d) A ball in or beyond the ditch on the 8th hole, noted by signage.
- e) A ball in or beyond the ditch on the 18th hole, noted by signage. f) The road dividing the course, even if the ball comes to rest beyond the road on another part of the course.

ovable Obstructions (Rule 16-1)

- a) All posts defining Penalty Areas are Immovable Obstructions and free relief is only available when ball is deemed to be outside the hazard, otherwise Rule 17 applies.
- b) Young trees supported by stakes. If the tree interferes with the stance or area of intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted and dropped in accordance to Rule 16-1
- c) All artificial structures, paths, greenkeeper's sheds, junction boxes, shelters, steps.
- d) All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 16-1. In addition, if such an obstruction is on or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows:

If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard & is within two club lengths of the intervening obstructions, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which is

- 1) Not nearer the hole.
- 2) Avoids such interference.
- 3) Not dropped on the green or in a hazard.
- White posts with a black painted tops with indicative Out of Bounds sign. f) Rake holders are deemed Immovable Obstructions, free relief permitted
- under Rule 16-1, ball to remain in bunker.

Red Penalty Areas (Rule 17)

The margins of the penalty areas are either defined by red lines, red posts or where the ground falls away creating the natural border. DO NOT REMOVE RED POSTS.

Integral Objects

Artificial bunker faces are not part of the bunker and are deemed to be in the General Area

Overhead Cables

If a ball strikes an overhead electric cable, telephone wire or support cables the stroke MUST be cancelled and replayed without penalty.

Animal Dung in Bunkers (Rule 16-c)

Free relief may be taken under Abnormal Ground Conditions Rule 16-c, if the dung interferes with the lie of the ball, area of intended swing or stance. The ball must be dropped in the bunker, no nearer the hole
